

Checking In

In order to ensure a smooth and effortless check in, please note the following:

- Please send us an Airbnb message (or text us) to <u>let us know that you have successfully arrived</u> and gained entrance.
- Check in time is any time after 2:00pm (unless otherwise arranged in advance)
- A few days before your stay, we will send you (via the Airbnb message system) a unique door code to gain entrance through the front door.
 - To open the front door: Simply press the code into the pad. You should hear it click and the door will open. You do not need to use your mobile phone or internet access to gain entrance. It's a simple key code you punch in.
 - To close the front door: When you leave the house simply shut the front door and press the lock icon on the key pad for a few seconds until you hear the locking mechanism set. Test to make sure the door is locked.
- Please remember your unique code for the duration of your stay. It will be deactivated a few hours after your final check out for the safety of future guests.
- There is a <u>back door near the kitchen</u> that has a traditional key lock. (does not operate on the keyless lock like the front door). Please ensure that this dead bolt is locked from the inside when you are away from the house.
- <u>Park your car(s) in the private drive way or in the car port</u>. We do not recommend that you park on the street. Please remember to lock your car(s) at all times when parked on the property. Safety first!
- Please leave the front porch outside lights on at all times.
- <u>Log on to our free, secure Wi-Fi</u> using the password you will find in this guest guidebook.
- Help yourself to the <u>water and provisions</u> in the kitchen.



• Message us if there are <u>any issues that need immediate attention</u> or if you have any questions about the house, property, or amenities.

Checking Out

Please follow these steps as you prepare to check out:

- Check out time is 11:00am (unless otherwise arranged in advance)
- Please double check that the front door and side kitchen door are locked and secured. Also please leave the front porch light on before departing.
- <u>Please remove the sheets</u> on all beds that you used during your stay. For any beds that you did not use, please leave the clean sheets as you found them. That way, we'll know that we don't need to launder the sheets.
- Place any <u>bathroom towels</u> you used during your stay on the floor of the bathroom (or in the tub). If you did not use a towel and it is clean, please leave it on the towel rack as you found it when you checked in.
- Please <u>let us know if there are any unusual stains</u> on the towels or sheets so that we may pre-treat the stains prior to laundering.
- Place any <u>dirty kitchen towels</u> that you used in the bathtub along with other used towels upon check out.
- Please place any <u>dirty dishes in the dishwasher</u> and run the dishwasher before you check out. You will find dishwasher soap/pods underneath the sink.
- Take only memories. Leave only footprints. Please throw out any garbage you
 have accumulated and place in the outside garbage bin before departing. That
 includes any remaining food in the refrigerator/freezer, kitchen area, bathroom
 and bedrooms. Thank you!
- <u>Log off any digital media</u> that you may have loaded on our TV, such as Netflix, Amazon, Hulu, etc.
- <u>Check around the house one last time</u> for any items that you may have left behind, including electronic devices, and personal items.



- Please send us an Airbnb message (or text us) to <u>let us know that you have departed.</u>
- <u>Travel home safely</u>.
- <u>Write us a review on Airbnb regarding your stay with us (within 14 days). You can also send us a private message giving us specific suggestions for improvements.</u>
- Come and stay with us again the next time you're in Greenville! THANK YOU!

House Rules

We want you to thoroughly enjoy yourselves, but please remember:

- No smoking (including vaping) of any kind in the house or on the property (including cigarettes, cigars, e-cigarettes/vapes, etc.).
- No parties or large gatherings.
- No under-aged drinking.
- No marijuana (even for medicinal purposes).
- Quiet please. Please keep noise to a minimum out of respect for neighbors, especially after 9 p.m.
- No pets allowed in the house.
- No overnight sleeping on the living room sectional couch as it is not a sleeper sofa.
- Help us to conserve water, energy and laundry. Please re-use the same towels
 and bed linens during your stay. Please limit the number of beds you use so as to
 keep laundry requirements to a minimum. Turn off all lights (except on the porch)
 when not in use.





- <u>Firearms are strictly prohibited</u> in the house, on the property, or in vehicles parked on the property.
- No illegal activity may be conducted while you are in or on our property.
- Park your car(s) in the private drive way or car port. We do not recommend that you park on the street.

Telephone

There is a red telephone in the living room (near the large screen TV) for emergency use - in the event that your mobile phone battery dies or if you have connection issues. You can both dial out and receive calls on this line.

From this house telephone, you can dial 911 for emergency response teams, or 411 for information, or call numbers within the United States.

You will NOT be able to make international calls or premium/pay calls with this number, as they have been blocked.

Our cell phones are pre-programmed in the address book of the red phone if you need to contact us.



Television & Music

- We have a <u>Roku-enabled television</u>, which allows you to stream your favorite movies, music, and TV shows directly from the Internet.
- There is also a <u>USB port</u> where you can plug in your device to access your own stored movies.



• For your convenience, we have <u>preloaded our Amazon Prime account</u> from which you can watch free movies and free TV shows (shown with the Amazon Prime icon). You cannot download or watch any pay-for movies or

programs using our account. You can however, do so using your own Amazon Prime account.

We have <u>preloaded Pandora</u>
 <u>music on the television</u>. Look for
 the symbol and connect. We
 have set it up on our account so
 you can enjoy commercial free
 listening without interruption.
 You are welcome to add new
 music stations but please delete
 them before you check out.



- If you have a Netflix account, you can access it from the TV by inputting your account information. Be sure to close out your account prior to check out.
- We also have many <u>DVD movies</u> that you can watch. They are kept in two places:
 a) in the red Ottoman near the fireplace
 b) in the bottom drawers of the bookshelf in the 2nd bedroom.
- Please keep the <u>two remote controls</u> (one for TV and the other for DVD player) on the fireplace mantle when you check out.
- If you need to <u>recharge your smartphone</u> or other digital devices, you'll find a convenient outlet under the vinyl tree art and the red bench in the dining room.



Kitchen

- There is no garbage disposal in the sink, so please remove any solids in sink and place in garbage can
- Garbage can for your general trash is located inside a kitchen cabinet under the area where the toaster oven is. If your trash level exceeds the indoor can, please use the external garbage bin outside near the carport. Pick up is on Wednesday morning.



- You will find a <u>recycling bin</u> under the kitchen sink (on the left). We can recycle glass, plastic, and paper.
- <u>Please place your dirty dishes in the dishwasher</u>. If you want to hand wash dishes, there is a microfiber dish drying towel in the drawer to the right of the oven.
- When using the oven, do NOT use foil to line the bottom of the oven as the heating unit will melt the foil and cause damage to the pan. (Note: If this occurs, you may be charged extra cleaning fees.)
- In the <u>cabinets and drawers</u>, help yourself to many of the basics to help you prepare and serve meals and snacks.
- We have a <u>toaster oven</u>, rather than a toaster.
- <u>Coffee</u> (regular and decaf) is in the refrigerator. If you prefer instant coffee or enjoy tea, there is a selection in the cabinet to the right of the stove.
- The <u>coffee machine uses a gold filter</u> that can be reused. No paper filter needed. Please do not throw the gold filter away. If you purchase your own coffee, we recommend buying coffee grounds for drip machines.
- If you prefer to prepare your coffee with a <u>French Press</u>, you will find one in the racks below the kitchen island. Please dispose of coffee grounds in the trash can and do NOT put them down the drain.
- Please enjoy the <u>filtered water in the Brita pitcher</u> in the refrigerator.



• You are welcome to shop for groceries and prepare your own food, but please take with you or <u>throw away any remaining food upon check out</u>. See list of nearby grocery stories in the Shopping & Entertainment section.

Laundry

- There is a <u>stackable washer/dryer</u> combination unit in the pantry closet to the right of the refrigerator. We have provided laundry soap for you. You will find it either on top of the washer, or in the pantry with the hot water heater (in the closeted pantry to the left of the refrigerator).
- If you need to do some <u>hand washing</u>, you will find Woolite under the sink in the bathroom.
- If you need something dry cleaned, we have a very good professional <u>dry cleaner</u> very close by Masters Mark Dry Cleaning. They offer same day service if you turn in garments by 10:00 a.m. Otherwise, a 24 hour turnaround. Address is: 1701 Poinsett Hwy, Greenville, SC 29609. Phone is 864-370-3601. - There is a <u>mesh laundry bag</u> in the master bedroom closet for your convenience. Please be sure to take all your garments when you check out.





Bathroom Amenities

- We have stocked the bathroom medicine cabinet with various amenities in case you forgot something. Feel free to use what's there.
- When <u>replacing the toilet paper</u>, lift UP on one side of the silver dispensing rack. It's easy once you figure out how it operates.
- In case of emergency, we have a <u>toilet plunger</u> and also a <u>toilet scrubber</u> next to the toilet.
- Please do NOT flush sanitary napkins, condoms, diapers or anything like that in the toilet. Rather, please place these items in <u>brightly colored OUT disposal bags</u> that are located in the medicine cabinet. Then throw the bag away in external garbage can that is located near the car port. Best to get these items out of the house as quickly as possible.
- Please do not use the white towels to remove your make up or with temporary color/dye for your hair, as this will ruin the towels. We have provided make-up



<u>remover pads</u> in the medicine cabinet. If you have dyed/colored hair, please let us know and we will provide you with dark towels to use.



Temperature Controls


Heating & Cooling

This home is heated and air cooled through a forced air system. There is one central thermostat (white in color) which is located on a wall in the living room, near the hallway leading to the bedrooms. Brand is Honeywell.

Perrydise

On the same thermostat you can move the level to Cool, Off, Heat, or Em Heat (emergency heat).

The thermostat screen will show you two temperatures: the current temperate inside the house, and the temperature we have programmed it to.



- Heater will kick on if the temperature goes below 67°F
- Air conditioning unit will kick on if the temperature rises above 75 °F

If you like, you can adjust the temperature programming to change to accommodate your desired level of comfort.

If you prefer it to be a little cooler or a little warmer, you can easily adjust the temperature by pressing the up and down arrow buttons on the thermostat.

Please keep the FAN button on Auto. No need to change it to On.

If possible, please <u>keep the windows closed</u>, as it will keep the house cleaner, quieter, and more regulated.

<u>Extra blankets</u> can be found in the closets of each bedroom.

If you would like to use an <u>electric fan</u> for more focused cooling, just let us know and we can provide you one during your stay.






We live in Travelers Rest (or TR as the locals call it). We want to encourage to check out all it has to offer. It is a charming town, connected to Greenville via the Swamp
